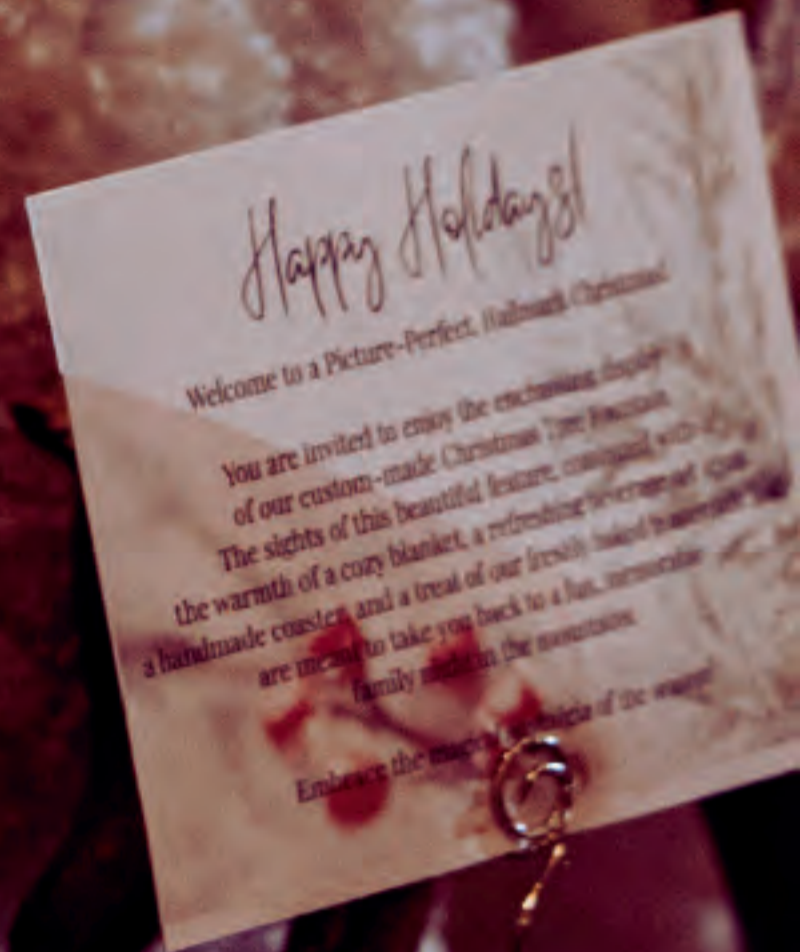

Here I go again, "Happy New Year" and let's bring in 2026 with a bang. I do remember ringing in the new year at the Atchison's house for the millennium of 2000. What great fun that was way back then. We had a house full and sadly to say, some of them are no longer with us. Of course, this was when Walden was still a small subdivision with a lot of weekenders, no elementary school and the Spin In was our only store and gas station. Boy have things changed in the past 25 years.



Now for gardening which is going to be very little if any this month. The end of November and the beginning of December turned out to bring us much needed rain

and definitely cooler temperatures. Remember that January is the time to plant new roses, but you also must remember a few things. They must have 6-8 hours of sunshine per day and the deer love them. If you want additional trees in your yard or more shrubs, again, now is the time to plant them. Just remember, don't plant when a freeze is in the forecast. 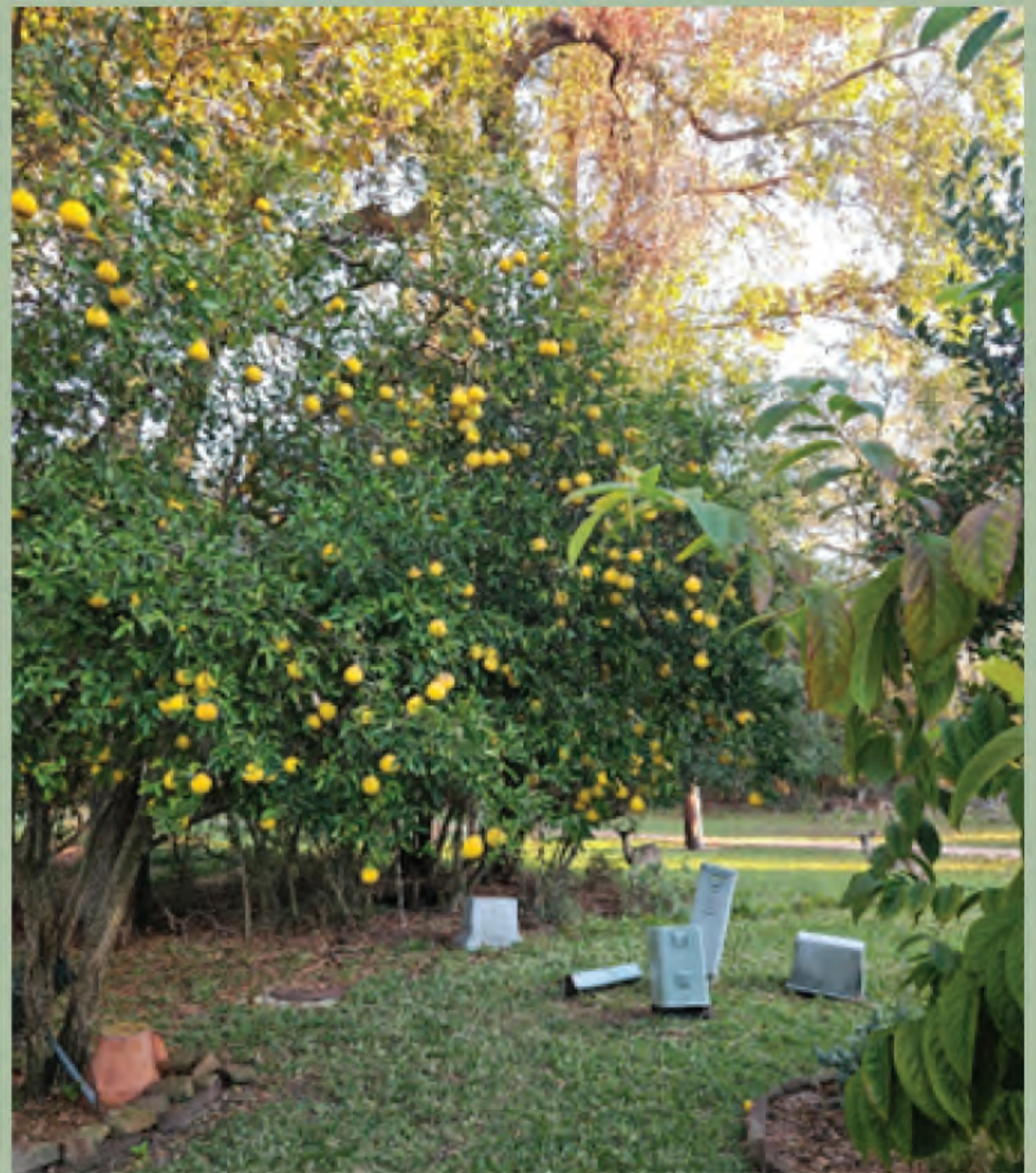

We have had enough rain, and everything is dormant so why water?


