Top Texas E-Bike Laws-Texas Transportation Code, Chapter 664.

What You Need to Know for Safer Riding and Understanding Texas electric bicycle (e-bike) laws is important for safety and legal operation on the road. This is to help you understand the law, key riding regulations, and to ensure you're fully informed. These laws are found in the Texas Transportation Code, Chapter 664.

Key Takeaways: Texas law classifies e-bikes into three categories: Class 1, Class 2, and Class 3. E-bike riders must follow traffic laws like traditional bicycles, helmet laws for those under 18, and speed cannot exceed 28mph. Any bike without functioning pedals and exceeds 28 mph, or has a motor with more than 750 watts, makes it an "electric" motorcycle, requiring Texas Class M license, registration, inspection, and liability insurance. We are now into a beautiful time of year in Texas. Spring is here and we have daylight saving time which I dearly love. As I stated in last month's newsletter, our weather was all over the map. I can honestly say that I have never removed spent leaves or cut back anything at the end of February or beginning of March.

I have always waited until mid-March. I have featured pictures of my Mexican Honeysuckle numerous times and I have to tell you, I decided to just remove the dried leaves and let it green up on its own. It worked beautifully. It's like, why cut it way back so it has to grow the stalks again and then produce the vegetation. Having said that, doesn't this also fit with murdering your crape myrtle trees and making them regrow their limbs? I can only preach this so many times and some of you still will insist on taking your crape backs all the way. Look and see if you have the black mold on them now. You might want to rethink how you treat that tree.

I applied my herbicide and weed and feed but remember last year I had Take All Patch, so I am biting the bullet and removing a large chunk of my front yard, putting down some good soil and laying new sod. I can't write a gardening article and have an ugly front lawn!

Depending on what type of vegetation you have in your flower beds, you should be so impressed with all the new growth. My little john bottle brush, they had all dried-up leaves and now they are sprouting new growth so guess what, yes, just remove the spent leaves and let the new growth take over.

Your lawn should be nice and green if you applied

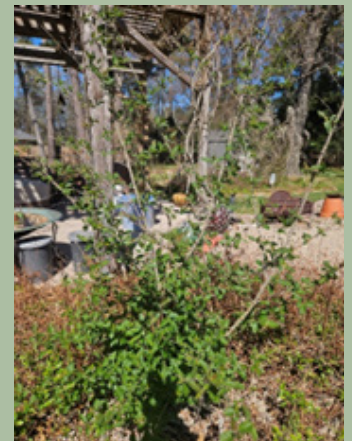
15-5-10 and now you need to apply Nitro Phos Super Turf 19-4-10 or Sweet Green. I personally will be doing the Sweet Green on my lawn.

When you visit the library in Montgomery, be sure to walk around Memory Park. You will be amazed with everything in bloom. March was a great month for the azaleas in the park. We are adding a few more memory gardens so I think you will be impressed. Remember, there are 4 donation boxes located within Memory Park and we will take any type of contribution that you want to make. I know that senior pictures will be taken which is another good reason to contribute to the donation boxes.

I forgot to remind you that March is the time to shape up your oleanders so go ahead and do it now. Last year I told you about a place off HWY 105 West (towards Navasota) where you turn on FM 362 or CR 362 (towards Whitehall) that has a beautiful area to view the bluebonnets. I should have also stated this in last month's article. I have had two months of a lot going on so that will be my excuse.

Tip of the Month:

Water is good for your garden, but just as in life, too much of a good thing can be a detriment. Over watering can cause a flood and wash away soil and necessary nutrients. Establish a regular watering pattern and stick to it. Your plants will come to expect their daily quench, and it might become a life-giving routine for you as well.
