# IN THE *garden*

I hope that everyone had a wonderful Easter. We attend Lone Star Cowboy Church, and our Easter Sunrise service is always held in the outdoor arena. Well, we were sure glad that the rain held off, but I can say that with the north breeze blowing, it was mighty chilly. We have gone from heat to a/c and back to heat so many times but as I always say, in Texas just wait a few minutes and the weather will change. We have gotten a decent amount of rain, so your yards and flower beds show be really green, and everything is starting to bloom, especially if you are following my fertilization schedule. Don't forget that May is when you need to do your herbicide application with Barricade Preemergence Herbicide. If you didn't fertilize in April with Nitro-Phos SuperTurf 19-4-10 or Sweet Green Organic, please do it now to provide a boost to support strong growth and density. Also, have your lawn service raise their mower blades to 4 or 4.5 inches. The taller your grass, the more moisture it will hold and protect the roots.

Many types of annuals tend to leave their spent blooms hanging around looking ugly. Zinnias are a good example. Snip these spent blooms off (deadhead) and cut back to the first set of leaves. Doing this promptly as blooms start to fade away allows the plant to put its energy into more blooms rather than into seed production. Petunias will tend to bloom themselves into a weakened state and will succumb to the heat of summer if they are not rejuvenated. Cut them back by about one-third and follow with fertilization and water to promote fresh growth and more blooms. Don't wait until they decline to do the pruning and rejuvenating and be ready to repeat the process a month later if they are still around. May is a great month to fertilize all your shrubs and bedding plants. I personally like to use Color Star (granular) and Miracle Grow for a topical foliar feeding.

Plant perennials now that won't flinch in summer heat. Focus on Texas native plants if possible. Be extra diligent about watering these new plants to help them transition as their roots venture out from the container media into the surrounding soil. Even drought-tolerant perennials need a little extra TLC until their roots establish and they become quite resilient.

As many of you know, I volunteer at Memory Park, and we just finished a new garden for Harriett Kerr who worked in the Walden Golf Pro Shop for many years (she passed away January 2025). The soil at the park is not the best to say the least. I've previously used rose soil when I had to work with gumbo and clay. It is amazing. I hope that you will venture to the park to look at all the new gardens that we have done. I was amazed when talking with some ladies at Easter church service and they had no idea that Memory Park existed. For those of you that don't even know that we have a library in Montgomery, turn right on C. B. Stewart Dr. off SH 105 which leads to Ransom's Steak House. At the stop sign, turn left and go to the next stop sign and turn right. There you will see our very own library and Memory Park is located just behind it. It is very dog friendly (poop bags available) and an enjoyable place to take a walk, sit on one of our numerous benches and look out over our large pond. If it is your first visit, be prepared to spend an hour or so. It takes that long just to stop and read all the signs that we have on the gardens, trees, our reading area, butterfly garden, waterfall, rainbow bridge, get the idea????? Oh, before I forget, we do have four donation boxes located around the park and any amount you deposit offsets our maintenance cost so please contribute. So many people come to the park for family pictures, graduation pictures, engagements, etc., so for us, every little bit helps.

## Tip of the Month:

Our current gardening trend is to design modern, stylistic gardens with austere lines and hyper-defined borders. This is all fine and good, but remember that gardening is meant to be relaxing, regardless of how loose or fit your space is. The best gardens leave room for surprises.
