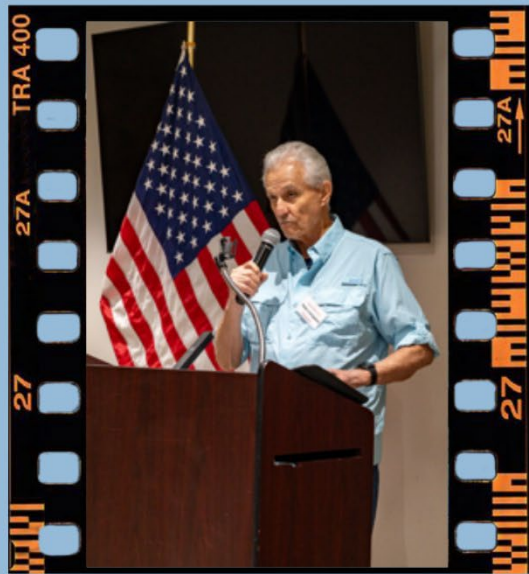


MEN'S ASSOCIATION *of* WALDEN

MAY Luncheon





IN THE garden

Can you believe that school is already out, and summer is officially here. You also know that this is the beginning of our hot season. We had adequate rain the month of May which helped keep our lawns nice and moist and of course green. Please pay attention to your sprinkler system. Start out with minimal days and add more only if necessary.

Some of you have been complaining about mosquitoes on the NextDoor App or the various Walden Facebook pages. I have been using a product for about 5 years now called Aion Mosquito Barrier. You can probably find it at C&S Feed in Montgomery or go online and see if you can find it. I personally bought every single one that Jim's Hardware had when they were going out of business. It is easy to fill, doesn't require power, continuous long-range protection and creates a barrier for living spaces.

June is the month that normally two things happen to trees – one good, and one not so good. Bark lice – good guys! - spin white stocking-like webs around tree trunks. They eat harmful insects in bark. Leave them alone! Spider-like webs and brownish bags around branch ends are webworms and bagworms – bad guys! Their larvae hatch and eat new growth on trees. They won't kill strong trees, but they will certainly weaken them. Break the bags open. The worms will fall to the ground where birds can eat them.

Things to remember to do this month are; #1 Early morning watering of your potted plants is best. Give them a good soaking so they can withstand the afternoon sun.

#2 If you are growing roses, they like at least two inches of water a week.

#3 Cut back on fertilizing all plants when it gets hot and if you know that a rain shower is going to happen, put some fertilizer down then.

#4 If you buds are turning brown and falling off, you have thrips. Remove the thrip damaged buds immediately.

#5 Spider mites cause foliage to lose color in the leaf center. Attack the spider mites with a hard water spray on the undersides of the leaves and after the sun goes down, apply neem oil. You can also use insecticidal soap which is effective

against aphids, mites, and whiteflies. And, last but not least, keep your hummingbird feeders cleaned and filled.

If you happen to have yellowing leaves near the tip of your azalea shoots, this is an indication of a lack of iron. Go get a bag of Ironite and spread around your plants.

Until next month, enjoy the beauty of your yard that you have created and please remember to drive slow through the subdivision with the kids out of school.

Tip of the Month: The best gardens aren't plant and go varieties. Gardens will bring you the most pleasure and peace if you do a daily walk through. Appreciate the beauty, check for bugs, and make corrections as needed. In short, be present in the world you created.
