PRESENTING WALDEN'S 2026 INDEPENDENCE DAY

GRAND MARSHAL ~ MR. JOHN TRYON



Walden is proud to recognize longtime resident, volunteer, and patriot John Tryon as the Grand Marshal of our 2026 Fourth of July Parade.

Many residents know John through the countless community organizations and events that he and his wife, Gaby, have faithfully supported throughout the years. What some may not know is the remarkable story of his service to our country.

John enlisted in the United States Navy and proudly served three tours during the Vietnam War. Following boot camp, he attended Damage Control School at Great Lakes Naval Training Center and later trained at the Philadelphia Naval Training Center. During his first tour, John served aboard the aircraft carrier USS Constellation (CV-64). For his second tour, he was stationed at Cam Ranh Bay, South Vietnam, with the 301st Seabees Construction Battalion, where he helped operate and maintain the U.S. Naval Air Base. During his third tour, he returned to Vietnam and served with a small

Seabee detachment in Da Lat and Phan Rang, helping build housing for Vietnamese families and designing and constructing a chapel at the Naval Air Station.

In November 1970, John returned to the United States. He married Gaby and was assigned to the Seabee Base in Gulfport, Mississippi. While stationed there, the couple welcomed their first son. John completed his military service in February 1972 and was honored for his dedication and sacrifice with the Vietnam Technical Medal of Honor and the Bronze Star. After leaving the Navy, John returned to civilian life, first working alongside his father before beginning a distinguished 28½-year career with Shell Oil Company. When reflecting on his life, John humbly says there are two things he knows he got right: "I married the right woman, and I went to work for the right company after my service to the United States of America."

Today, John continues to embody the values of service, commitment, and community that make Walden such a special place to call home. We are honored to celebrate his military service, his volunteer spirit, and his many contributions to our community as this year's Fourth of July Parade Grand Marshal.

Please join us in thanking and congratulating John Tryon for his service to our nation and his dedication to Walden.

IN THE garden

Here we are in the heat of summer. May and the first part of June turned out to be quite wet for us. One thing I like about my Rachio sprinkler control panel is that I can go to each zone, and it will give me the moisture content of that area. It's really pretty cool, so if I find an area that is dry, I can just water there. All from my phone. You can easily change out your control panel for this more sophisticated one.

I applied my Sweet Green Organic fertilizer, and my yard looks like it is on steroids. It almost needs to be mowed twice a week and the mower blade is kept at 4 ½ inches. I haven't really needed to fertilize all my greenery as the rain has given my plants plenty of nutrients. If you are looking for butterfly weed or rain lilies, please shoot me an email. I have tons to share.

This is the time to prune your roses very lightly to keep them productive and vibrant during the hotter summer months. You can also fertilize with Nitro-Phos Rose fertilizer. Keep the area around your roses clear of debris that can harbor insects.

Make sure you don't over water your drought tolerant plants like lantana, yucca, vitex, oleanders, salvias, etc. If some of your container plants seem to be wilting more than usual, move them to a shadier spot. Lanky growth may indicate that plants are reaching for more sun.

Do you have plants that put out a good smell? My favorite large shrub/small tree is an Almond Verbena. I think I have four of them planted in different areas of my yard. They put on a white flower spike that has the most incredible fragrance. I purposely planted two at either end of my swimming pool area so I can enjoy the smell. Plants use fragrance primarily to attract pollinators. Individual scents attract bees and butterflies, promising the reward of nectar and/or pollen. White flowers tend to have more fragrance because they are more difficult for an insect to see than a red flower. In terms of intensity of fragrance, red flowers come next followed by yellow and purple.

I happen to have a Rangoon creeper vine growing on my palapa (I have volunteers if you want some) and it produces clusters of flowers that start off red, then turn pink and finally white. It also has a wonderful smell. Did you realize that plants with purple or blue flowers rarely have a smell? Give your blue plumbagoes or salvias a sniff and see what you think.

Many nights blooming plants are white, unlike during the day, white flowers are easier for

moths (night pollinators) to see in the dark and their particularly intense fragrance further helps the moths in their search. Night bloomers also attract bats, which help in the garden by happily consuming great quantities of insects.

Some plants have aromatic oils in their foliage that are released only if they are brushed against or crushed, such as copper canyon daisies. The foliage often has this strong scent to protect it from browsing animals, which are repelled by the leaf oils. This plant is also hated by the deer which is a good thing and it's beautiful when in full bloom which usually happens late summer to early fall.

Fragrance in plants varies considerably with atmospheric moisture, and it is generally more prevalent in warm, moist, and still climates, like ours here. Heat warms up fragrant oils, releasing their scents and humidity prolongs the smell by reducing the rate at which the oil evaporates.

Now, I assume that all of you have soaked in all this information and are very knowledgeable about plants with scents. Now, go out and enjoy the smells in your gardens and enjoy July.

Tip of the Month: If you frequent Nextdoor or Facebook for happenings in your area or are looking for things to buy or sell, that's great.
