IN THE garden

It is really hard to believe that I'm sitting outside on a beautiful windy day writing my article for May. Our weather has been gorgeous this April and YES, we have had cool mornings and warm afternoons but that's what Texas weather is all about.

As we near the halfway mark for 2024 remember that the kids only have about three more weeks of school left. I've been working at Keenan Elementary since the first of February and will finish out the school year there, so my afternoons have become my special time working in my flower beds. I've been doing a plant swap with one of the teachers so I'm anxious to see how my new peach trees do along with a few other trees that I've acquired. It's always fun to find someone that loves plants like you do. Those of you who know me know that my flower beds have no structure. For me this brings me happiness to know that whatever wants to grow and give me color is welcome. If for some reason I feel that it just doesn't belong there, I move it to another location.

Do you remember as a kid growing up with a little black bug that if you touched it, it would curl up into a ball? I always called them doodle bugs. Some people called them roly-poly or pill bugs. Do you realize that they are beneficial to your soil? While cleaning my beds this spring, it seems that every rock I moved had Doodle bugs under them. Here are a few facts about the doodle bug.

Roly-Poly and pill bugs can have several benefits in the garden and ecosystem. Some of them are as follows.

1. Decomposition

Roly-poly and pill bugs are important decomposers in the soil food web. They feed on decaying organic matter, such as dead plant material, and help to break it down. This process releases nutrients into the soil, which can benefit plants and improve soil health.

2. Soil Aeration

As they burrow through the soil, roly-poly and pill bugs help to improve soil aeration. This allows oxygen to reach the roots of plants and improves soil drainage, which can benefit plant growth.

3. Pest Control

Roly-poly and pill bugs can help to control other pest populations. They prey on other small insects and arthropods, such as mites, which can be harmful to plants.

4. Food for Wildlife

Apparently, roly-poly and pill bugs are an important food source for many animals, including birds, reptiles, amphibians, and small mammals.

So, if you have roly-poly and pill bugs that live in your garden, no need to worry. They are good for Mother Nature.

May is also the time to apply your herbicide and I always recommend Barricade so go ahead and apply it to help with weed control. If your lawn does not have the best color and you have bare spots, consider applying some leaf compost. Your grass will thank you and this mixture is full of nutrients. You might also want to check some of your trees to make sure that they are not providing too much shade. Trees periodically need a trim job to allow more sunlight through. Another thing to remember is that your tree branches need to be reaching upward now downward. With hurricane season coming you also need to make sure that you do not have any tree branches hanging over your roof.

Remember that we are getting into our hotter months and your beds really need mulch. Not only does newly applied mulch help eliminate weeds, but it helps your beds retain moisture. This alone will help reduce your water bill.

Tip of the Month:

Zinnias are traditionally a happy flower, and you can't go wrong offering a loved one a bouquet of brightly colored zinnias. In particular, the scarlet zinnia signifies constancy and steadfastness. 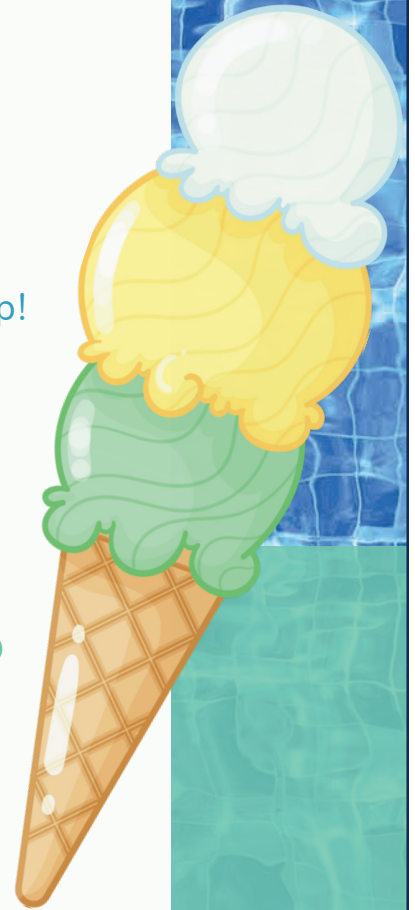
