Constables are elected for four (4) year terms, and he must be a certified peace officer. Their main duties include preserving the peace in their precincts. Constables support the court system including serving subpoenas, summoning jurors for the courts, and making arrests for offenders of the Code of Criminal Procedure



Our next meeting will be June 7th. The speaker will be Dr. Mark Ruffin, Superintendent of the Montgomery ISD. Dr. Ruffin will have a couple of his staff talk about the Mentoring program and the district's financials after the new property tax homeowner exemptions are passed by the legislature. IN THE *garden*

As most of you know, I have to submit my article one month in advance and sometimes it's really hard to do, especially if we have had extreme weather. All I can say is that the beginning of May was beyond extreme. With Lake Conroe rising above 205 it brought back memories of two previous incidents. I can remember back in October of 1994 when we saw record flooding. I decided to do just a bit of research. Back on October 19, 1994, Lake Conroe actually rose to 205.58 MSL (mean sea level). We had a slow-moving storm drop of 20-30 inches of rain throughout Montgomery County and the surrounding area, causing flooding that had never been seen before. I remember looking out my front deck doors at the lake and saying holy ---- I can't believe this. Low and behold it happened again when Hurricane Harvey hit in 2017. The lake actually got to 206. I didn't know that the lake's maximum design water surface level is 207 feet above MSL, and that the dam's crest elevation is 212 feet, and it allows for an additional 6 feet of flowage easement during extreme storms. The reservoir is designed to operate so that peak releases from the dam are always lower than the peak inflows into the lake. This is done by temporarily allowing the water level to rise within the 6-foot flowage easement to reduce risk to life and property on both sides of the dam. I personally would hate to think what would happen to our lovely neighborhood if it ever reached 207. You also have to remember that Lake Conroe acts as a water shed for the neighboring counties north of us. I hope that you found this information as interesting as I did. This is only the 3rd time in the past 30 years so we should probably count ourselves lucky.

Now, for some gardening advice and suggestions. If the majority of your mulch washed away from the heavy rains, you will need to put more down to protect your plants this summer. Remember, mulch helps keep moisture in the ground. I'm thankful for a fellow Waldenite who called to tell me that he had 12 bags of pine-straw from cleaning off his roof. I jumped in my truck and picked it up before someone else decided that they wanted it. One good thing about using pine-straw instead of bark mulch is that it stays put even during torrential downpours. The plants like the acidic nature of the pine-straw and it also helps keep down the weeds. If you need of some, shoot me an

email. We stock it for use at Memory Park and might possibly have some to sell you.

With all of the rain we've had, your plants and shrubs should be growing like crazy. Remember the nutrients in rainwater benefit the plants and grass. If you are replacing some plants, remember that a garden also needs movement. Attracting beneficial wildlife, taking advantage of gentle winds.

Come summer, when breezes are often scarce, softly swaying foliage and flowers have a cooling effect.

Butterflies, hummingbirds, and other birds among our plants bring a sense of tranquility to our often- hectic lives. Ornamental grasses are one of the best sources of movement. Consider placing ornamental grasses among your flower plantings. They also serve as beautiful frames and backdrops. Hardy salvias, coneflowers and russelia attract butterflies and hummers. For more movement, consider one of my favorites - pride of Barbados.

Arrange vines so a few tendrils sway freely. Plant palms and ferns where breezes can create soft waves. Position fragrant plants in areas you occupy so scents will waft through the air. I always know when my Almond verbena and Rangoon creeper are blooming. I can smell them when I pull into my driveway.

Pruning lower branches off tall shade trees will encourage more air movement underneath. Finish everything off by adding some wind chimes.

Now, go out and have some fun in your gardens. I know I'm going to.

Tip of the Month:

This was brought to my attention, and I thought I'd share this with you. Whenever you are working in your garden, please remember to always wear gloves especially when trimming a sago palm. Did you know that sagos are very poisonous (no wonder I don't like them)? A friend got a sago sticker in her finger, and not only did she spend several days in the hospital, but she also had to have surgery to clean out the poison. She also had to have fungal and bacterial IV treatments after returning home. For more information on this, google brandondonnelymd.com/palm-thorn-injury.

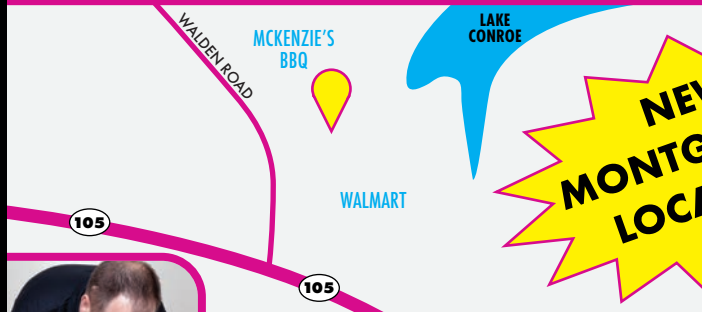

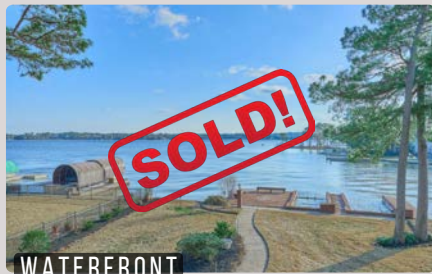
