Effective IMMEDIATELY, the change in policy for court reservations for COVERED courts is:

1. Only one covered court can be reserved per group or team.
2. Covered court reservations MUST BE MADE BY PHONE even if in the pro shop, between 8:00am & 8:30am. All reservations proceed as normal after 8:30am.

Beginning next season, leagues will NOT have priority for covered courts during peak time (8am-10am) if it rains. This enables members who are not part of leagues to have an opportunity to play on rainy days.

\$60,000 budget for courts and furniture, with the furniture taking priority. \$7,400 per 2 court to resurface.

Proposal for approval: Give out free tokens for lighted courts, eventually switching to timers that do not require tokens. (Rob will discuss with David Hartman)

Ninety-four players participated in the Super Bowl mixer, which included tennis and pickle ball. It was a huge success. Due to large growth Walden's member relations budget will be reviewed after 6 months to accommodate the new amenity.

April 4 Walden has been selected to host Racquet Wars, a mixed doubles and women's tournament. Should be around 300 people participating in the event. Great opportunity for our Walden residents to participate in.
