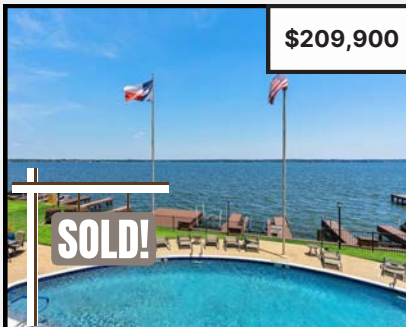

IN THE garden

We are officially into summer. The first part of May again gave us much needed rain to help promote growth on our newly planted plants and green up our lawns. I hope this weather pattern continues for the month of June.

This month you will have odd jobs to do outside. Last month I told you about raising the lawnmower blade so make sure you do this. If not, you will be sorry. You will also need to apply 19-4-10 Nitro-Pho's fertilizer to your yard like you did back in April. Remember, you can now buy it at C & S Feed Store in Montgomery. If you have noticed a lot of Bermuda grass in your yard and are wanting to get rid of it, there is an easy solution aside from digging it up and replacing it with St. Augustine. If you let your St. Augustine grow and keep your lawn mower set on high, it will give the Bermuda enough shade to kill it.

For those of you that travel a lot during the summer, and you have potted plants that your neighbor oversees during your absence, group them all together for easier watering. You can also put your hanging baskets in this grouping. Find a nice spot with not too much sun so they won't have to water every day. You can also purchase a product called "Vacation". It is an all-natural, anti-drought plant treatment.

After being treated with "Vacation", plants will be drought resistant for up to two weeks. Your nice neighbor will thank you for this.

This is also hummingbird season so make sure

that you keep your feeders cleaned and filled. It's best not to use red food coloring to attract the hummingbirds. Remember, it is 4 to 1 sugar and water. I have so many things in full bloom in my yard that I really don't need feeders.

About 15 years ago I told you of a way to get rid of cock roaches that you may see in your garage. They scurry across your garage floor late in the evening. If you take a beer bottle with just a little beer left in it and place it on the floor, the next morning it will be full of roaches. Try using a Corona bottle which is clear and see how many you get each evening.

Tip of the month:

Even with regular watering habits, your summer ferns may lose their bright green color or stop growing altogether. If this happens, try submerging the pot in water to saturate all the soil. A thorough soaking should perk up your leaves even in mid-summer. SARA BETH MCKAY, TIP AND TRICKS IN THE GARDEN.

Walden Boat Ramp Rules & Reminders for Summer 2025

As summer & the holiday weekends approach, we'd like to remind all Walden property owners of the rules in place for using the Walden Boat Ramp. These guidelines help keep the ramp area safe and accessible for everyone, especially during the busy holiday season.

After launching your boat, please return your trailer to your home whenever possible. Trailers and boats may be stored in your driveway for up to three days. If you need to leave your trailer at the ramp, it must be removed within 24 hours. Trailers left beyond this limit will be towed by WCIA. To avoid the inconvenience and cost of towing, we strongly encourage you to leave your name and a contact number so that we can reach out before towing becomes necessary.

For our condominium & townhouse owners, please note that boat and trailer storage at your residence is not permitted under community restrictions. However, you may store a trailer at the ramp for up to three days with a special sticker. This sticker can be obtained through your property management office or by visiting the Deeds Office at 11715 Walden Road. The office is open Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., and you must register in advance to receive the sticker. Trailers left longer than 72 hours without proper authorization will be towed.

We also ask all boaters to observe the No Wake markers when exiting the cove to ensure safety and respect for fellow residents and boaters.



Exterior Projects & Seasonal Maintenance

Just a small reminder to all property owners: if you're planning to paint your home, install a new roof or gutters, or begin any type of exterior improvement project, you are required to submit your plans to the ACC for approval before starting. The good news is it's quick and easy to do! You can submit your project online by visiting our website at www.waldenonlakeconroe.com, or feel free to call our office at 936-612-0011 for assistance.

In addition, as spring winds down and summer begins, we kindly remind everyone to power wash the exterior of your home, as well as your mailbox, driveway, and walkways, if they show signs of mold or algae buildup. This is part of Walden's Home Exterior Maintenance Policy, which is enforced to help maintain the beauty and value of our community.
