# Red, Hot & Blue Potato Salad

## Ingredients:

- 2 lbs. Red Potatoes
- 4 hard-boiled eggs
- 1/4 cup fine chopped green onion tops
- 3/4 cup mayonnaise (add if necessary)
- 3/4 teaspoon celery seed
- 3/4 teaspoon salt

## Instructions:

1. Steam the potatoes skin-on for approximately 45 minutes (you can boil them, but they tend to be slightly mushier in the end result).
2. Boil the eggs (medium-hard).
3. Peel the eggs ONLY (do NOT peel the potatoes - the skin gives it part of its unique texture and taste).
4. In a large bowl, mix the remaining ingredients together until thoroughly mixed.
5. Rough chop the potatoes and eggs into bite-size pieces and add to the bowl. Mix GENTLY - you want salad, not mashed potatoes.
6. Serve warm - refrigerate leftovers. It tastes best when room temp, but is delicious cold too - so if you are making this in advance, it's fine to chill it.





## INGREDIENTS:

- 2 (3.4 oz.) boxes instant white chocolate pudding
- 4 cups whole milk
- 1 (14 oz.) angel food cake, store-bought
- 2 (8 oz.) containers Cool Whip
- 32 oz. fresh strawberries, washed, stems removed, sliced & pat dry
- 18 oz. fresh blueberries, washed and dried

# Berry Beautiful Trifle



## INSTRUCTIONS:

- Let Cool Whip thaw. Cube the angel food cake and prep the berries (wash, dry, remove stems and any bad spots).
- Prepare white chocolate pudding with cold milk as directed. Chill until set.
- Layer cake cubes at the bottom of a trifle bowl.
- Spoon and spread half the chilled pudding over the cake.
- Line the bowl with sliced strawberries, then add a full layer of strawberries on top.
- Add a layer of blueberries over the strawberries.
- Spread one container of thawed Cool Whip on top and smooth with a spatula.
- Repeat layers—cake cubes, remaining pudding, strawberries, and blueberries.
- Decorate the top with the remaining strawberries and blueberries. Chill before serving.

# IN THE garden

As our summer months begin to heat up, hopefully the afternoon rain showers will continue. June proved to have given us some nice rain. Having said that, hurricane season is upon us. As you will remember, it was last July 8th that hurricane Beryl visited us. Most of you were without power for days. I on the other hand was in Mexico while hubby had emergency surgery. Our 10-day vacation turned into six weeks and luckily a good friend came to my house and hooked up our portable generator and saved everything in my freezer.

After doing some research, NOAA (National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration) says that we are to have 13 – 19 named storms (60% above normal) and that 6 – 10 could become hurricanes with 3 – 5 majors. In comparison CSU (Colorado State University) says we will have 17 named storms with 9 becoming hurricanes with 4 being majors. They also stated that there is a 70% chance that named storms will track within 50 miles of the Texas coast and a 44% chance within striking distance. I found it interesting that both parties basically said the same thing. Let's pray that if we are hit, it will be mild.

I've previously told you about how to get rid of mosquitoes in your yard. There is a product called Spartan and from what I understand, they changed their formula, and it wasn't as effective, so I quit buying it. There is a new product called Aion mosquito barrier. They come in a box of two and trust me, they work. They state to replace them every 90 days. I've left mine up for 6+ months. If I start seeing mosquitoes, I know to replace it. BTW, did you know that the male mosquito doesn't bite, it's only the female! What's up with that?

I have noticed a lot of Virginia Buttonweed in my yard and the only thing that will kill it is a product called Celsius. It's not cheap but it works. Living on 3 lots I actually went through 3 gallons spraying wherever it was. It took some time walking slowly back and forth through my yard spotting it. All you have to do is look for the bright green leaves and the tiny white flowers. I would suggest spraying it now before it takes over.

I seem to be on a roll so I will give you just one more tidbit. I've had an issue with Carpenter Bees. They resemble a bumble bee and are most active

in April and May which be their mating season. The female will bore a hole in unfinished soft wood such as redwood, cypress, cedar, and pine. Carpenter bees do not consume wood like termites but use wood merely to construct nests. Their tunnels are clean cut and may extend 6 to 8 inches. The females collect pollen and nectar to produce a dough-like mass called "bee bread". Eggs hatch into larvae that feed on the bee bread in their cells. Development varies with species and temperature but can progress from egg to adult in a little over a month. There may be 2-3 generations per year. It's best to treat your wood at first siting of the bees. I know that they are around when I see tiny flakes of wood on my patio furniture. It's a pain in the butt to treat but you need to do it. I use a product called Delta Dust. The kit comes with the powder to treat and the bulb for the powder. I just have to locate the holes and push the powder into the tunnel. I know that it's working when I see the bee bread and the larvae on the furniture.

Now, since I have given you all this information, go out and enjoy your yard and summer.

### *Tip of the Month:*

Four-O'clocks were originally grown for their medicinal properties. It's possible a nibble on these sweet flowers could cure what ails you, but I don't recommend you try it. Instead, enjoy the tender blooms that open, as their name suggests, in the afternoon and last through the sultry evening hours. WENDELL BANCROFT SR.
