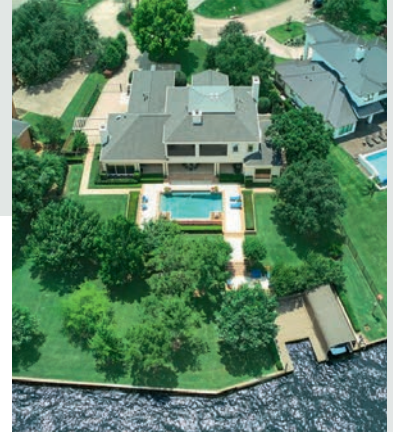

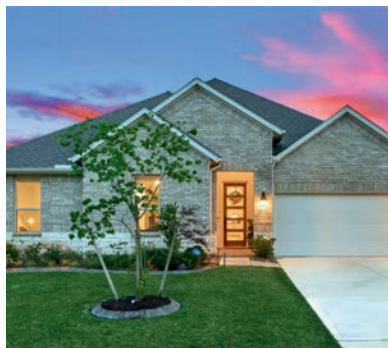

IN THE garden

It seems like yesterday I was wishing everyone a safe and fun summer with school being out and now I'm talking about school starting up for the 2025-2026 school year on August 14th. Where does the time go?

While May and June gave us ample rainfall, I'm hoping that July will produce the same, remember, my article is written 30 days in advance so one can only hope and predict.

As you Texans well know, August and September are our hottest months so you NEW Texas transplants, get ready. Yes, you are going to sweat like crazy but look at it this way, sweating is healthy. Make sure when you are outside that you keep hydrated and don't forget the sunscreen. Having said that, the best gardening tip I can give you this month is to stay inside and view your garden from the air conditioning but, if you can brave the 100-degree heat, give you perennials, annuals, roses and fall blooming shrubs a light feeding and slight pruning. I like using Miracle-Gro, which not only gives the roots a good feeding, but it is a wonderful foliar feed. Azaleas suffer from intense

heat so if that is happening, keep them watered as they are setting their spring blooms. The root system of the azalea is very shallow, and their roots want to grow laterally, not necessarily deeply. I had fun redoing one of my large flower beds. I decided to use nothing but Texas native plants and I'm really liking the way it is turning out. This bed will hopefully give me color all year long as the majority of the plants will not lose their leaves in the winter. The plants installed were Russian Sage, Coral Nymph Sage, Hot Lips Sage, Mexican Bush Sage, Tunera and Mystic Spires Blue Salvia.

On another note, the Doe's have been giving birth like crazy so don't forget to protect your plants by using liquid fence or some other type of deer spray and remember, C & S Feed in Montgomery carries a variety of products and if they don't have what you are looking for, let them know and they will get it for you. It's always nice to support our small local companies.

Keep in mind each person's needs, gathering supplies for at least three days. Stock up on items such as non-perishable food and water, first-aid supplies, prescriptions, pet supplies, flashlights, and batteries. Keep all electronic devices fully charged.

Secure copies of important personal documents as obtaining government assistance requires documentation. Keep documents in a secure and dry environment and take them if you need to evacuate.

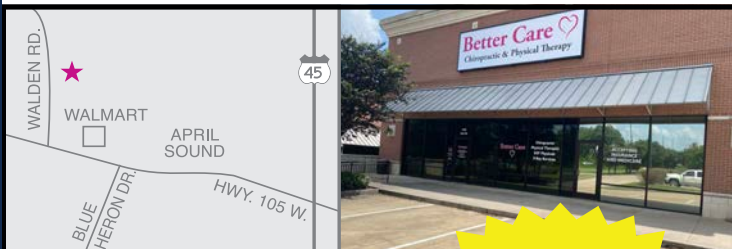
