15 will not be accepted, regardless of postmark or email request date. We encourage all interested property owners to apply.



IN THE garden

It's official, in August we finally started to experience Texas summer heat. The few potted plants that I do have needed to be watered every other day and if it was in a natural clay pot, it needed to be watered every day. One of the great benefits of having decorative ceramic pots is that your plants don't dry out as quickly as when they are in just a plain terracotta pot.

Despite our warm August, we managed to get a shower here and there to help our lawns out. Now with September we should see a slight downward trend in the temperatures.

This month doesn't bring a whole lot of activity in our gardens. If you have a fenced backyard and can have a small vegetable garden, now is the time to purchase those plants, especially tomatoes and peppers. With our growing population of deer, you need to be protecting your plants. I use Plantskydd, Liquid Fence and my own nasty concoction. My favorite name for deer repellents was from years ago and I found

it at a hardware store in Houston. The name was Not Tonight DEER Lol.....

Eagle Specialty Fungicide needs to be applied this month. Brown patch is the most prevalent fungal disease in our yards at the present time. Just look for dead circular areas in your yard and this is your indication that you need to treat your yard.

Remember, with Jim's Hardware closing, I've been directing everyone to C & S Feed located on FM 149 right in downtown Montgomery. Grab lunch at Phil's Roadhouse and then go across the street and get your fungicide, fall vegetable plants and deer spray.

Tip of the Month: Our current gardening trend is to design modern, stylistic gardens with austere line and hyper-defined borders. This is all fine and good but, remember that gardening is meant to be relaxing and fun. The best gardens leave room for surprises. *Dr. Julius Grisson, The Grissim Guide*

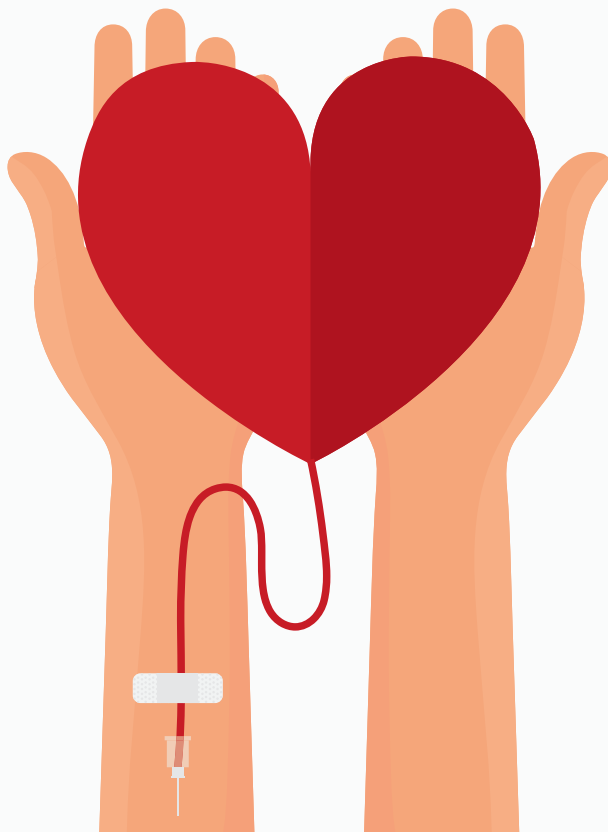

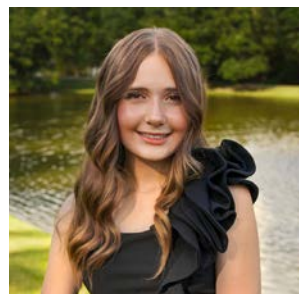

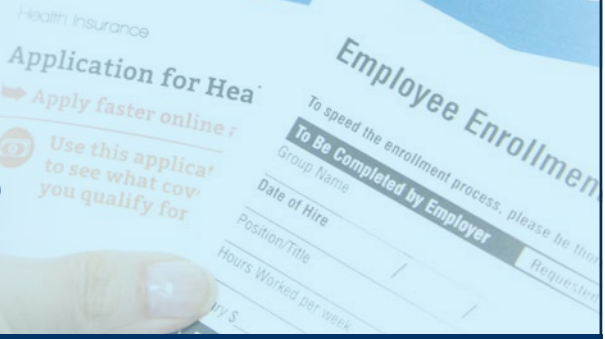
