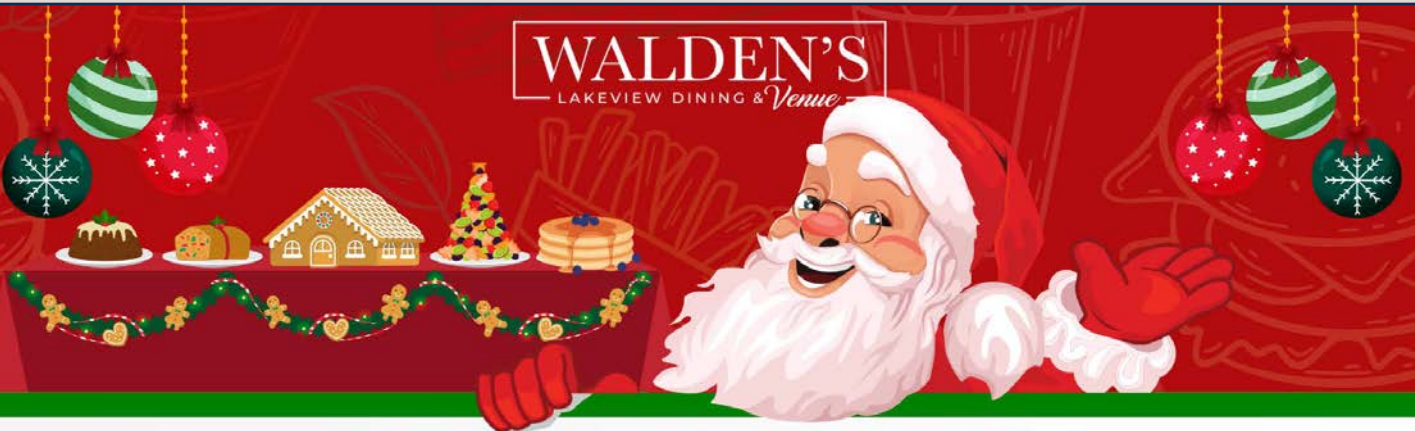

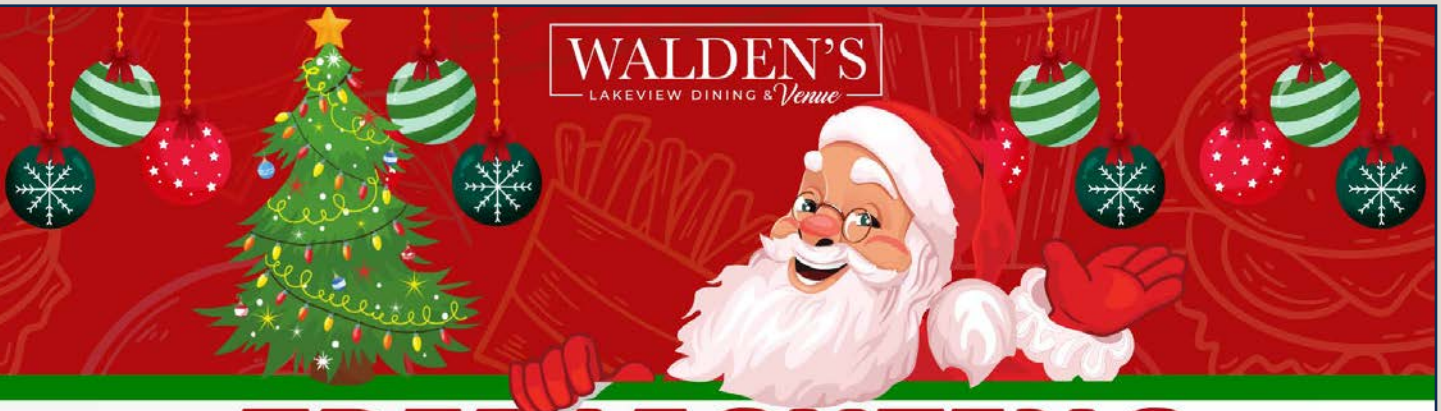

# IN THE *garden*

Well, we just celebrated Halloween and it's time to think about Thanksgiving. Planning the menu and making sure that everything is perfect and of course eating more turkey and dressing than we should.

Mums are for sale everywhere. I wish that Wal-Mart would do a better job of watering their plants. I personally love mums. If you visit Memory Park, you will notice that we have them planted everywhere. They are a no brainer. They bloom multiple times a year and are a tough sun loving/semi shade plant. For some reason the white and yellow ones do best at the park. It's also nice to have a combination of orange, red and yellow throughout your flower beds at this time of year. They do need their spent blooms removed and it's really easy to just pinch them off. You will then see more sets of blooms underneath. These mums will also continue to spread in your flower beds which is an extra bonus. Just sit back and enjoy but remember, they do like water. Another proven deer safe (as of right now & subject to change) is planting dianthus, they are a real trooper.

Speaking of water, if you have your sprinkler system running twice a week, cut it back to once a week. The

wetter your lawn stays, you are just inviting diseases.

All of the trees are starting to shed their leaves. You can add an extra layer of protection to the plants in your flower beds by placing the leaves and pine needles around them. I know that most lawn service companies tend to blow everything out of the beds including your valuable mulch but let's face it, it's winter and flower beds aren't supposed to look perfect.

Remember that this is also the time to put down your Nitro-Phos Fall Special 8-12-16 which can be purchased at C & S Feed Store in Montgomery and if you didn't do your fungicide in October, kill two birds with one stone and do it now.

This is a MUD 8 & MUD 9 announcement - Please DO NOT put flushable wipes down the toilet. The packaging might say flushable, but they are not biodegradable. These wipes contain particles of plastic and when flushed, the plastic separates from the cloth and they intertwine with each other and eventually wrap around our lift station propellers and clog the system. Also, do not flush any women's sanitary items. Please use your trash can for these items.

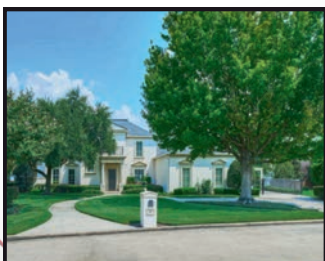

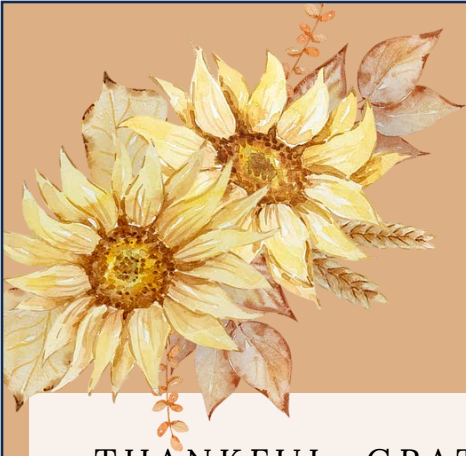
