IN THE garden

Winter doesn't begin until December 21st. And here I sit writing this article with a high of 87 degrees and we are having what I call our first winter cold front. Nothing like being 80 something degrees one day and a cold front blows through and we have a low in the 30's and a high in the 60's. As I have always said "Welcome to Texas". With all of the new eastern and western transplants coming to our area, they are going to have to get accustomed to our wacky weather. They will eventually get acclimated to it like the rest of you that were not born here.

December is a month to enjoy friendships and family and leave the gardening alone. If you do anything in your yard, it will be protection from the deer. I've always used Liquid Fence and my own made-up concoction, but I also ordered Bobbex since I feel that the deer get used to the taste and scent of other repellents. I have used this product before. It is used quite often in the Colorado area to help control the deer and elk. I purchased two 62oz. concentrated jugs which included a Chapin sprayer for about \$100.00. It's not cheap but hey, if it works it is worth it. A friend also told me about a deer repellent that she bought on Amazon that works. I've purchased a box and will see how it does in my yard. It comes with yellow essential oil scented discs that you place in a yarn bag and hang from areas where the deer are prone to gravitate. I will keep you informed as to how they worked. I will have photos at the end of this article to show you some of the destruction caused by the deer.

December is usually a month that we don't see a whole lot of rain so keep this in mind if you have turned off your sprinkler system. You might need to turn it back on a time or two to keep some moisture on your plants and shrubs. Your grass should be okay without rain since it is in its dormant state. Remember that now is the time to do major pruning on hardwood trees. They are in their highest state of dormancy between now and January.

If you have vincas (aka periwinkles) in your yard, they are dropping their seeds now which will in turn sprout in the spring. Make sure you have plenty of mulch around your plants and they might survive the winter. If they freeze, wait until springtime and prune them heavily and they should be just fine.



Tip of The Month - I was able to take an incredible trip to South Africa in September. We toured a winery called Babylonstoren that is set on 500 acres and was established in 1692. Not only is it a winery but the floral gardens were to die for. They also had a huge herb garden with each herb labeled with their medicinal purposes. All of their food was farm to table. I will feature a different herb/plant each month. Lamb's Ear – The leaves are soothing to the touch. Apply crushed leaves directly to stings, insect bites and cuts. Wrap wounds with leaves for protection
